

# ANSWER QUICKLY



## **Teachers Information:**

- Divide the students into groups of 3 or 4
- Pass out 1 activity sheet to each group
- Tell the students that they will be timed and given 4 minutes for this activity (the time can be adjusted depending on your class)
- When you say go, groups should flip their paper and fill in the blanks as quickly as possible
- When you say that the time is up, students should flip over their paper, answers facing down
- Next, have the students swap papers with another team and score together as a class



- Reward the winning team as you see fit

## **Extensions:**

- Have the students complete this activity individually
- Have the students only write answers that start with a specific group of letters (example: Have them they can only use the letters of their initials, or the first 3 letters in their name, etc....)
- Have the students scramble around the room & fill out their chart by getting one answer by everyone in their class. The first student to come up to you with 1 answer filled by out every student in the class wins! (If there are 20 students in your class, the goal would be to get 20 boxes filled out first.)
